THINKING GLOBAL: A meeting of 150 top minds on migration in Greece tries to get beyond the notion that Europe can solve its problems with illegal migration with stepped-up border patrols. Demetrios Papademetriou, co-director of the Washington, D.C.-based Migration Policy Institute, tells policy makers Europe needs to try instead to manage migration flows and integrate the migrants it gets. "Immigration must be part of every answer" before Europe can tackle other problems such as labor market reform, he says.
